Thank you for your notification of the Yorktown Branch to dissolve in order to form an independent organization to be named the Yorktown Preservation Society.

Preservation Virginia's Board met on 22 May and voted to approve the dissolution of the Yorktown Branch. The disposition of the site of the Thomas Nelson House will be deferred until such time as the Yorktown Preservation Society has received its 501 (c) 3 status. In its motion, the Board congratulated the Yorktown Branch on its many achievements and expressed their desire to continue a strong and collaborative relationship with the Yorktown Preservation Society.

The Board also instructed staff to prepare a resolution in honor of the achievements of the Yorktown Branch. We are undertaking that task and are happy to make that presentation at an appropriate time.

As a final step, I would ask that the treasurer of the Branch work with Cheryl Greenday to complete a final financial accounting of the Branch activities through 31 May. We ask that the accounting be completed no later than 31 July 2013. If there are any problems with that timeline, please let me know.

Frank, thank you for your leadership over these many years. We are beginning a new chapter in our work together. We are confident that this relationship will strengthen in the coming years because of the efforts of so many in the Yorktown area.
